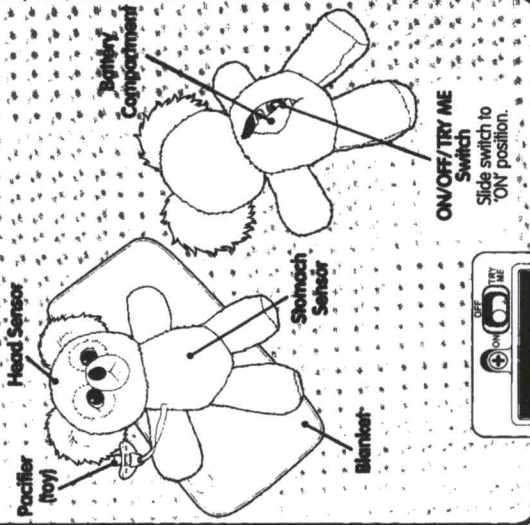

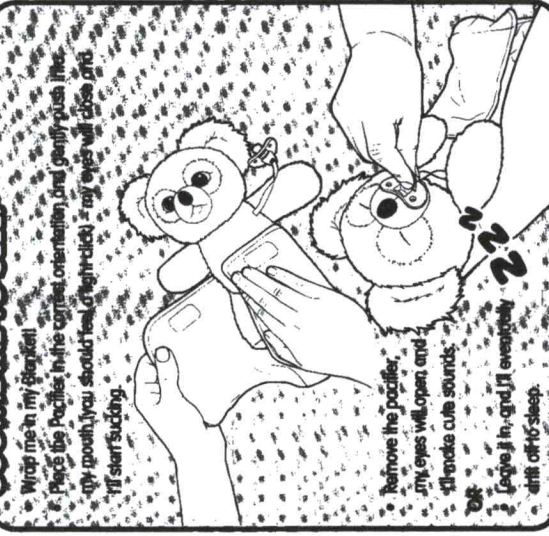


BATTERIES

Requires 2 x AAA (R61.5V) batteries. (Does not use the standard 1.5V AAA batteries. Rechargeable batteries not included. Works best with high-quality batteries. Caring for your batteries (not included) needed to replace batteries.

- Use new batteries to obtain best performance.
- Batteries should be recycled or disposed of as per state and local guidelines.
- Alkaline batteries recommended.
- Rechargeable batteries must only be recharged under adult supervision.
- Rechargeable batteries must be removed from the toy before recharging.
- Non-rechargeable batteries must not be recharged.
- Different types of batteries, or new and used batteries must not be mixed.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended should be used.
- Batteries should be replaced by an adult.
- Batteries must be inserted following the correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries should be removed from the product.
- The supply terminals must not be short-circuited.
- Batteries should be removed from the product when not in use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Batteries supplied are for demonstration purposes only and may require replacing within a short period of time.

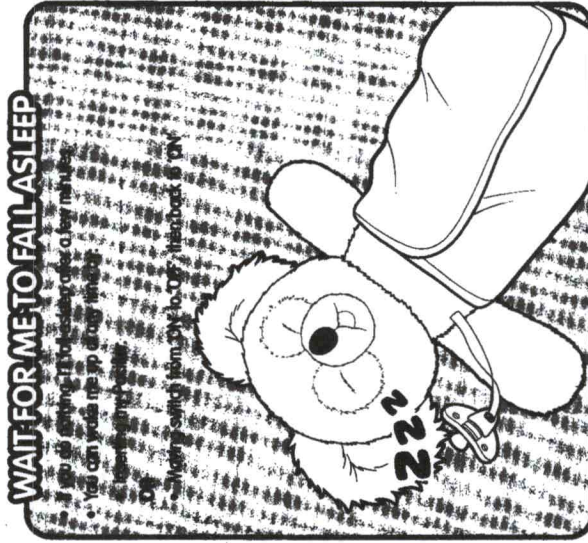
SOOTHE ME TO SLEEP

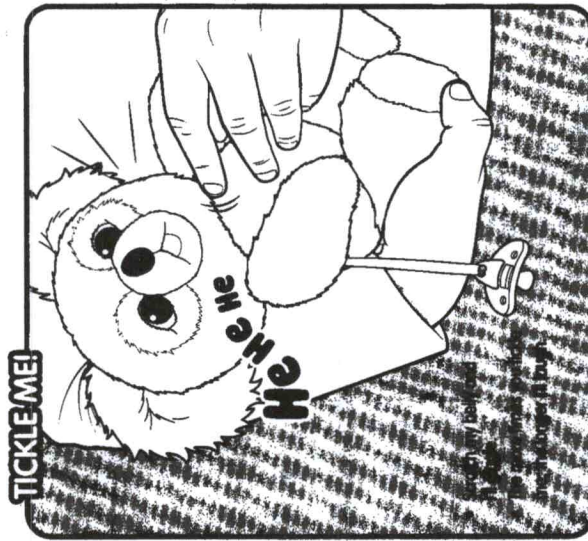

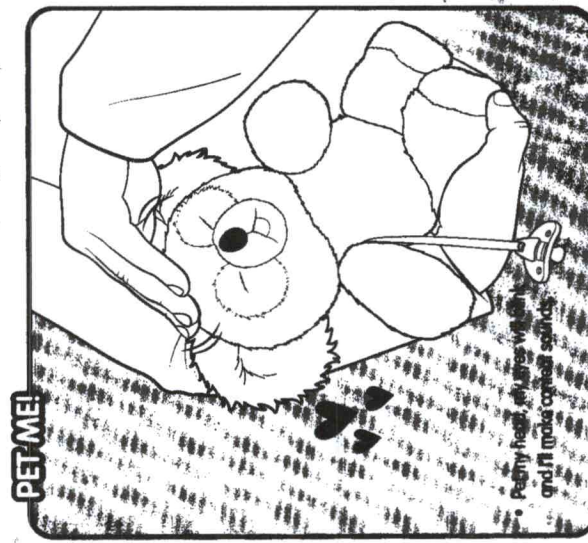
WAIT FOR ME TO FALL ASLEEP
